DDOT Traffic Advisory: I-295 Exit Ramp Closure Southbound on to Kenilworth Avenue at Ord Street June 2nd through June 4th, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close the exit ramp off I-295 Southbound to get on to Kenilworth Ave SB at Ord Street. Traffic will be advised to detour to the next exit to access Nannie Helen Burroughs Avenue.

The following roadwork will be ongoing daily during the working hours of 7AM - 3PM, beginning on or about Wednesday, June 2nd through Friday, June 4th, weather permitting.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
