DDOT Traffic Advisory: Left Lane Closure on I-295 Southbound between South Capitol St., SW and Chesapeake St., SW - July 29-31, 2021 (Night Work)

(Washington, D.C.) — The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close the southbound left lane on I-295 between South Capitol St., SW and Chesapeake St., SW for roadwork.

The roadwork will begin Thursday night, July 29, 2021 and continue through Friday afternoon, July 30, 2021 then resume Friday night, July 30, 2021 and continue through Saturday afternoon, July 31, 2021 from 7PM-2PM daily, weather permitting.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
